Change profile data and language in Studio free

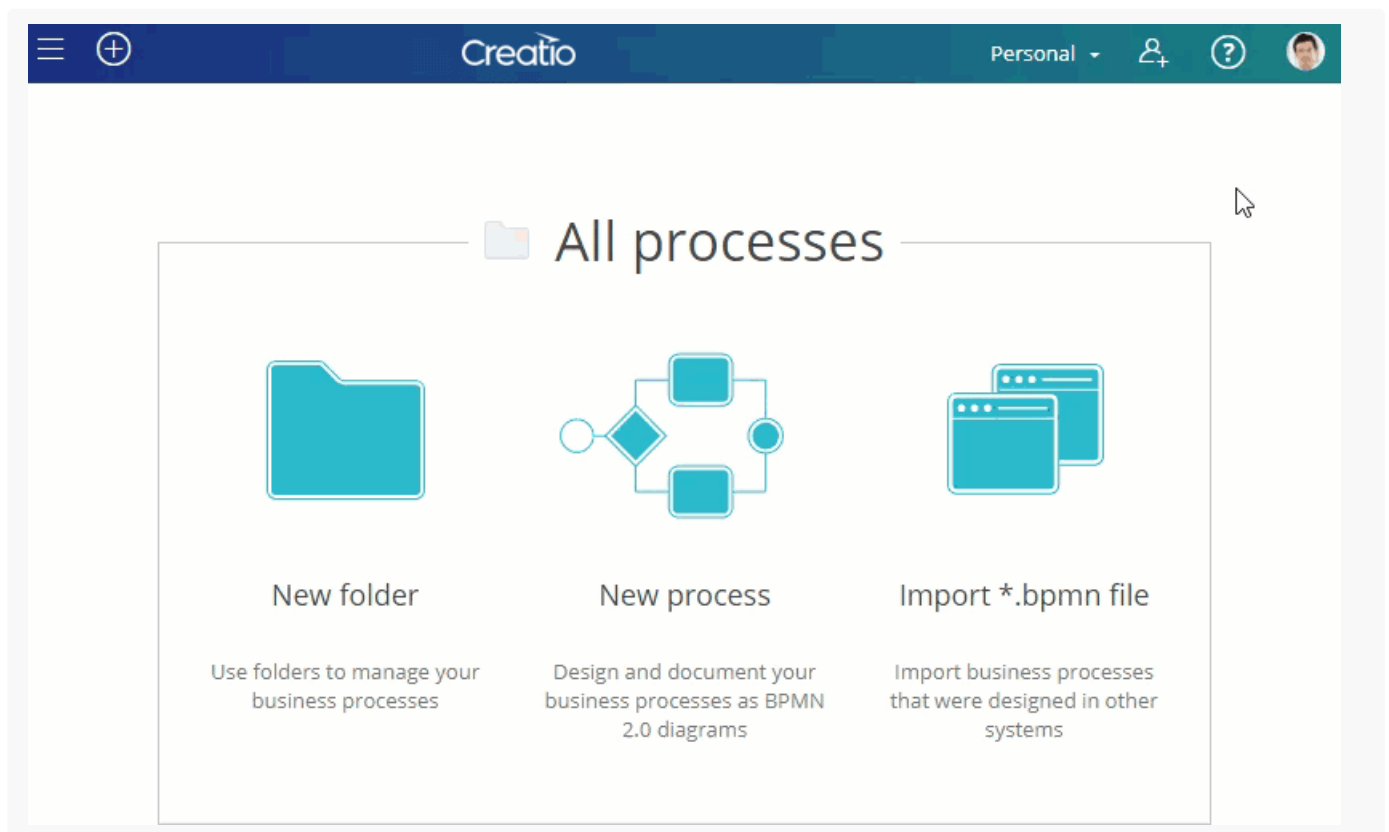

In Studio Creatio, free edition, you can change the visible name of the user, the application language, and the user profile password at any time.




Change your visible name

Your **first and last name** will be visible to other Creatio users who collaborate with you on the business process design. These names do not affect your login information. You can change your visible name as follows:

1. Click  and select the [*Profile*] command in the menu. Profile page opens.




2. Edit your name by typing in the [*First name*] and [*Last name*] fields.



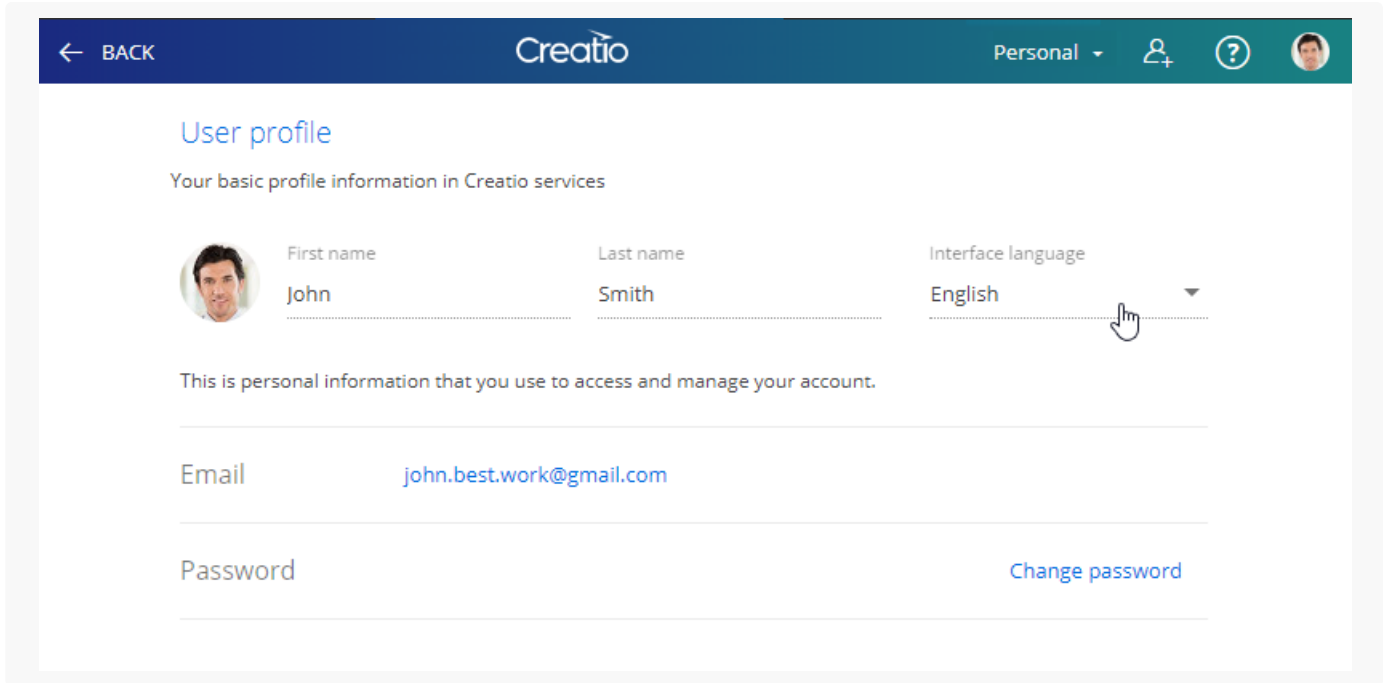

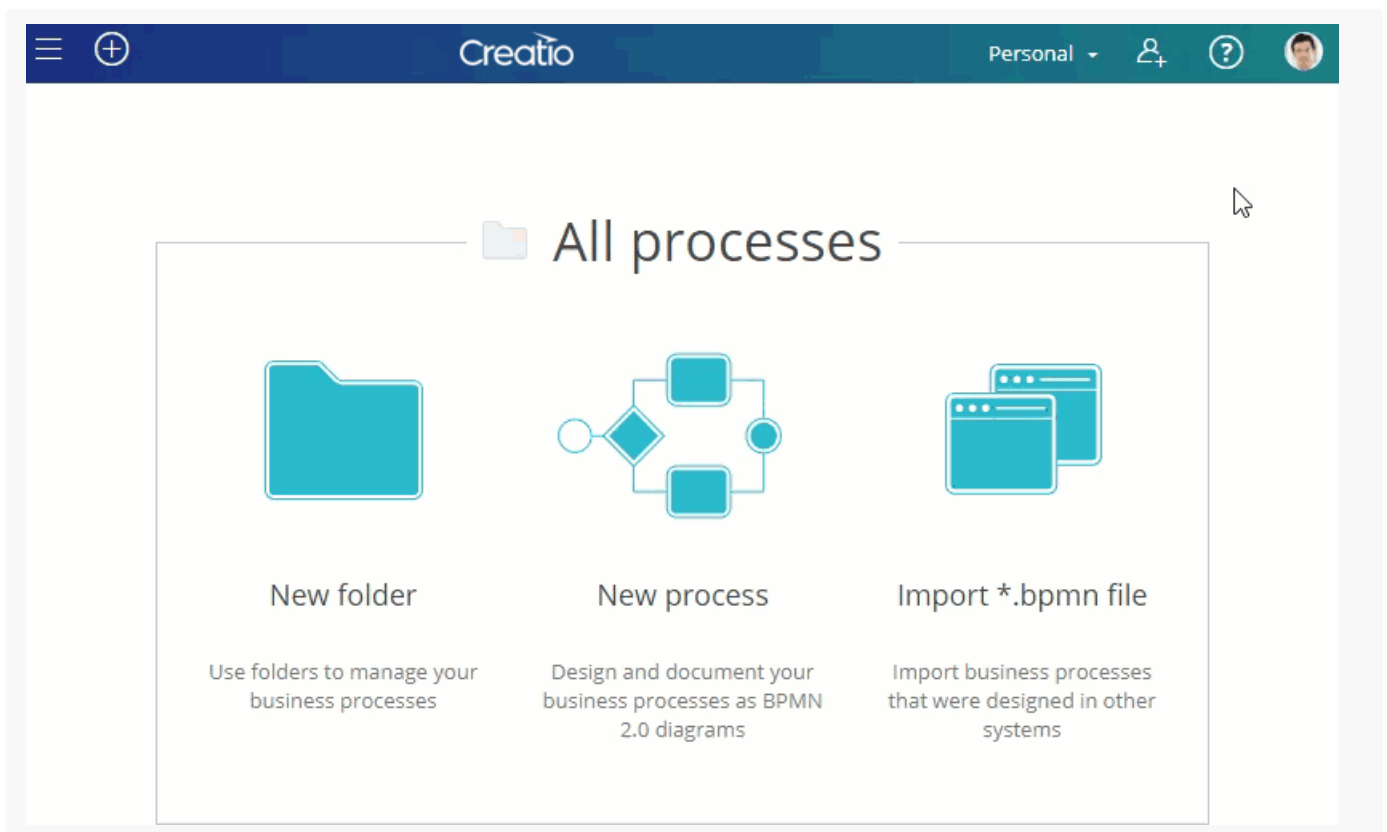




Change password

2. Click [*Change*] password.


